### RDC FINE HOMES AND HORIZON NORTH LAND FACTORY BUILT HOME MARCH 15<sup>th</sup>

Whistler BC, March 8, 2018:

RDC Fine Homes and Horizon North are building for the future with their Black Tusk factory-built project. RDC Fine Homes completed the Insulated Concrete Foundation work on March 5<sup>th</sup> and Horizon North will ship the two residential units from their Kamloops factory on March 14<sup>th</sup>. The landing crew will be onsite on March 15<sup>th</sup> to crane in the two completed residential units. “We are anticipating 30 days from landing the units to handing over the keys to the owner,” says Bob Deeks – owner of RDC Fine Homes. “Our RDC Fine Home carpenters will take care of a few tasks securing the units and then it’s a matter of streamlining local services like water and electricity.”

“Factory building is the future of the residential construction industry, and we are seeing more and more projects every building season. Of the projects we have scheduled for 2018 and 2019, the larger percentage are factory built,” comments Deeks. Factory built projects have clear advantages over site built: fixed time lines, climate-controlled fabrication factory (eliminating schedule delays due to weather) and can be less expensive than site built if managed properly.
